William G. Harris, PhD.D CEO of ATP (The Association of Test Publishers)

William G. Harris is an advocate for the testing industry. He frequently provides expert testimony on testing and assessment initiatives at the federal, state and provincial levels of government. G. Harris holds a doctorate degree in Psychology from the University of Massachusetts at Amherst, a master's degree in Business Administration from the Fuqua School of Business at Duke University, and a doctorate of Humane Letters from Excelsior College. His areas of interests are industry-wide issues including e-testing, test security, best practices and the impact of the digital age on the economics and future of testing. Under his leadership, increased attention is directed towards Europe and Asia and the growth of ATP in membership now comes from Europe. With this growth ATP is now positioned as an international trade association for the test publishing community. Besides establishing a global presence for ATP, G. Harris directs several industry-wide projects on test security and operational best practices, and he serves as the chair of the technical advisory group (TAG) for ANSI/ISO PC 230 initiative on occupational service delivery. He is a member of several organizational and editorial boards of directors.

ATP aims to promote and develop testing and assessment best practices and to facilitate an environment that would benefit test publishers, test takers, educational organizations and society in general.

When not advancing ATP's presence in Europe, G. Harris is spending considerable time in China helping to set the Chinese agenda for testing and preparing a series of articles about testing for Chinese business magazines.
